## **Performance Notes**

### **Soloists**

The Baritone and Flugel soloists are best placed on opposite sides of the stage  
and set slightly apart from the main body of the band.  
If a balcony is available this may also be a viable option.

### **Mutes**

The use of mutes is crucial to the colour and balance of the score.  
With the exception of the basses - who use straight fibre mutes both times - the repeated  
section at letter A should use straight fibre mutes for those who play 1st time and  
cup mutes for those who play second time.

### **Breath Marks**

These should be taken strictly as marked.  
Care should be taken not to breath immediately after any pause bars  
but to carry the phrase on to the next written breath mark.
